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KEY

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Trade Name: Name given to the medication by the manufacturer

Active Ingredients: Chemical names of the active components that make up the medication.

Withdrawal Time: Amount of time that must pass after the medication is administered before harvest.

Cautions and Warnings: Items to be cautious of when using the medication.

Storage Instructions: Method of keeping the medication by the manufacturer

Quantity of Contents: Amount of medication in the container.

Distributor's Name: Name of the company that distributed the medication.

Expiration Date: Date the medication should be discarded.

Lot Number: Reference number that the manufacturer uses to determine the batch in which the product was made.

Dosage: The amount of medication that should be given at one time.

Intermediate Vaccination Instructions

- There are 10 vaccine bottles with terms from a vaccination bottle and 10 vaccine bottles with the terms definition.
- Ask the participant to match the terms with the definitions by placing the bottles side by side with term that matches the definition.
- Ask the participant if they would prefer that you read the definitions on the cutouts to them, sometimes this makes them more comfortable.

Scoring: Each correct match is worth 2 ½ points for a total of 25 possible points at this station. Once the participant is finished please circle the number correct on their score sheet. Write the corresponding point value in the score box in the top right of the station box on the score sheet. Pass the score sheet to the facilitator behind you. Please do not let the participants see their scores.
